



# Hacienda Avenue

**Location:** Nr Fullerton, CA. eastern conurbation of Los Angeles

**Period:** mid 2000's to present

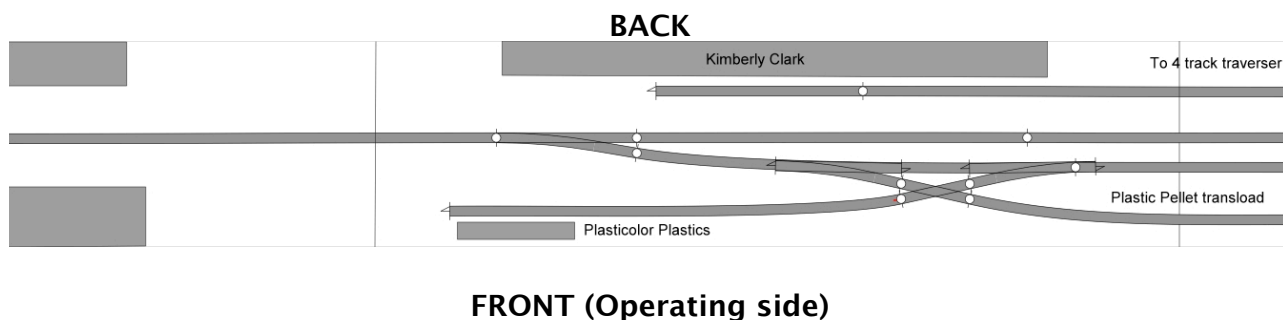
**Road:** BNSF (and maybe a bit of UP)

The inspiration for Hacienda Avenue is the Kimberly Spur industrial area near Fullerton, California. Along a spur from the BNSF main are a variety of rail served industry covering: distribution / warehousing, plastics goods, food production, paper products and a propane dealer and Each has a good variety small rail served industries that can modelled realistically in a small layout. Using a little modellers' license switching responsibilities can alternate between the aforementioned roads to allow me to utilise my collection of 4 axle switchers from both companies (and their predecessors)

From the variety of rail served industries 3 have been represented these being Kimberly Clark paper goods (hicube box cars), Pasticolor Moulded Products plastics (chemical tanks) and plastic pellet transload to road trailers.

The layout is DCC controlled using Digitrax. Locos are fitted with sound but volumes are adjusted to non-intrusive
